- Dancers for this production are people in their regular everyday clothing.
- **Feb. 5-7** students will bring 2-4 clothing options for their costume to class with all pieces labeled with name and class in a labeled bag. Clothing not used will be returned in mid-February and clothing used in the performance will be returned after the concert. All clothing used will be securely stored at Studio 720 until returned to the performer.
- All clothing needs to be comfortable and allow for large movements and be durable. As usual for dance clothing.
- Clothing from home will be supplemented with pieces from storage and items purchased by the Costumer. Each class will wear a different color.

Class	Class Color	Top:	Bottom:
<b>Cont. I</b>	<b>Reds and pinks.</b>	Solids, florals and patterns. Any style.	
<b>Cont. II</b>	Pastels of <b>lavender, purple, blue and aqua.</b> Patterned fabric is good as well as solids and combinations of these colors.	Leo-top, tank tops, sleeveless t-shirts or sleeveless dresses.	Bottoms-shorts, briefs, skirts
<b>Cont. III</b>	<b>Bold orange</b>	Bold orange tops of any style	Dark bottom-leggings or joggers.
<b>Modern I</b>	<b>Golds and yellow,</b>	Glitzy, sparkly and metallic for tops or dresses or skirts.	Bottoms are jeans or jeggings in denim.
<b>Modern II</b>	<b>Silver and blue</b>	Tops and skirts or dresses with some flow in sleeves or skirts.	Leggings or bottoms that cover the knees in gray.
